



Summer Camp Counselor



General description

The Summer Camp Counselor will be responsible for a group of children or youth to lead and engage them in daily activities including teaching of values, stories, arts and craft, recreation, field trips etc.

Responsibilities:

1. Develop and execute a comprehensive plan and program for the Summer Day Camp and related activities.
2. He/she will decorate and prepare rooms prior to the start date of camp.
3. The summer camp counselor will be an energetic individual who will be responsible for leading a group of 20-25 children throughout the day, and on field trips.
4. He/she will be to ensure that the schedule is always followed and that campers are taken care of at all times.
5. The counselor will also be responsible for subjects such as Arts and Crafts, storytelling, physical activity, and character building.
6. It is essential that the counselor have/attain teamwork skills as he/she will be working with the assistant counselor and other counselors.
7. He/she will develop essential fundamental skills such as communication, and how to assess situations and identify solutions.
8. In addition, they will attain personal management skills such as being responsible (taking care of children and working with others), being adaptable and learning to assess personal strengths and areas of development.
9. They will acquire problem solving skills as they have to resolve issues related to interaction among kids.
10. The safety of the children will always be at the forefront of this person's tasks and he/she will be aware of the personal and group health and safety practices and procedures.

To be eligible, students must

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
